This course certifies basic archery instructors for camps, 4-H clubs, Scouts, and other youth programs. SUBJECTS COVERED: a brief introduction to archery history, associations & programs, archery safety, range setup, group control, coaching philosophy, problem correction, teaching techniques, equipment selection, purchasing, maintenance and repair, formats for group instruction, archery techniques for disabled participants, archery games, contests, scoring rounds, variety and fun! COURSE PARTICIPANTS LEARN to teach young archers to shoot successfully, operate a safe program and build a safer range, improve simple archery equipment at a very low cost, order the right equipment for their programs, achievement patch and certificate programs for youth and, make archery a fun and enjoyable experience for everyone.



Ropes Instructor Training Courses

Qualification vs. Certification

A practitioner in Adventure Education activities needs to be qualified to run activities. In our training, we teach technical skills, facilitation techniques and other procedures critical for management of a successful program. We observe participants so we can document the level of proficiency they exhibit on that day. We offer an assessment of whether we feel that person is qualified to perform certain duties in an adventure curriculum so that their supervisor can make an informed decision **about that individual's role in their program. This training will not result in any sort of "certification."** Certification requires several components in addition to this training curriculum.

Certification is another level of documentation of the competencies of a practitioner. Certification, according to the ACCT Practitioner Certification Standards, provides a certain amount of uniformity in the areas that are tested. Certain tracks of certification are meant to be transferable. Not every practitioner NEEDS to be certified; it is merely a path of professional development that carries an outward uniform distinction. It is ultimately a decision each facility needs to make of what level of **certification, if any, will be required of which practitioner in order to meet the facility's risk** management objectives and satisfy ACCT Operational Standards.

This training is designed to meet the training requirements for ACCT Practitioner Certification exams. A written and practical skills test and submission of a portfolio documenting training and experience are required for certification according to the ACCT Practitioner Certification Standards. Arboreal Edge has been reviewed and approved by ACCT to offer training and certification at all levels and all tracks outlined in the ACCT Practitioner Certification Standards.
